Late-Night Vigil: Friday, March 1

Beforehand: Confessions from 4:30-5:00pm; Presanctified Liturgy at 5:30pm **Vigil Hours:** 7:00pm to 11:59pm

This late-night vigil will be a period of intense supplication. We will be praying through the Book of Psalms during the night. Half of each hour will be spent praying the Psalter while the other half will be silent contemplative prayer for participants.

Vigil sign-up: We need at least two people each hour. Please sign up for the earliest hour that does not yet have two people signed up. For example, do not sign up for 11pm if 7:00pm -10:00pm does not have at least 2 people per hour. Please note: Children and teens under age 18 are welcome and encouraged to join in the prayer. However, at least one parent or two unrelated adults must be present in the church while a minor or minors are present.

Next All Souls Saturday – Please bring a list of no more than 30 deceased loved ones to the Divine Liturgy on Saturday, March 2. Your loved ones will be prayed for by name for those in attendance who bring Fr. Michael a list before the Liturgy starts.
