PLAN AHEAD--make an appointment for your house blessing on or before January 15: With the feast of the Holy Theophany on January 6 comes the season of annual house blessings. **Now** is the time to book your appointment with Fr. Michael. He is available at 5pm or 6pm most Sundays, Mondays, and Thursdays until February 17. When you request a house blessing, please give your preferred date with two alternative dates that could also work for you. Make your request by email or physical note. Fr. Michael's email address is on the front page of every bulletin listed as "Pastor's e-mail." Thank you. **THE CUT-OFF DATE FOR APPOINTMENTS IS TUESDAY!**

Pastoral Visit from Bishop John: Bishop John will be at our parish from January 26 - 30, and will be present for the Divine Liturgies on Sunday, January 27 and on Wednesday morning, January 30. He and Fr. Michael will attend the Installation Mass for Bishop Daniel Garcia in Salinas on Jan. 29.

Cancellation and Changes: The vigil liturgy previously scheduled at 6:30pm on **January 29 has been cancelled, and replaced with an additional Divine Liturgy on January 30 at 6:30pm.** There will be no Divine Liturgy on January 29 as Bishop John and Fr. Michael are attending the Installation Mass that day (see above). Also note the **Friday, February 1 Great Vespers has changed from 6:30pm to 5:30pm.**

Next Parish Advisory Board Meeting: This will take place on Saturday, January 19 after the 9am Divine Liturgy. Observers (non-voting, non-speaking) are welcome to attend any of these meetings. Please be aware that occasionally part of a meeting might be limited to Advisory Board members only.

Stop trash can overflow: If the trash cans in the church parking lot are more than three-quarters full, please don't add any more! Take any remaining bags with you to deposit in your trash container at home. Fr. Michael uses less than a quarter of the container each week; the rest is used by the parish. But he needs that quarter of a can! So please take extra bags home with you so Fr. Michael is not stuck accumulating trash for the rats of San Luis Obispo!
