**REGULATIONS FOR THE GREAT FAST**

- 1. SIMPLE ABSTINENCE:**
  - A. The law forbids the use of meat and of meat by-products (e.g. beef broth), but permits the use of eggs and of dairy products.**
  - B. Simple abstinence is to be observed on all Wednesdays and Fridays of the Great Fast.**
  - C. All the faithful of the Eparchy who receive Holy Communion are obligated to abstain on these days.**
- 2. STRICT FAST:**
  - A. The law of Strict Abstinence forbids the use of meat, meat by-products, eggs and dairy.**
  - B. Strict Abstinence is to be observed on first day of the Great Fast, Monday. February 8, and on Good**

Friday, March 25.

C. All adult faithful – 18 year and older – are obligated to observe Strict Abstinence.
