REGULATIONS FOR THE GREAT FAST

1. **SIMPLE ABSTINENCE:**
 - A. The law forbids the use of meat and of meat by-products (e.g. beef broth), but permits the use of eggs and of dairy products.
 - B. Simple abstinence is to be observed on all Wednesdays and Fridays of the Great Fast.
 - C. All the faithful of the Eparchy who receive Holy Communion are obligated to abstain on these days.
2. **STRICT FAST:**
 - A. The law of Strict Abstinence forbids the use of meat, meat by-products, eggs and dairy.
 - B. Strict Abstinence is to be observed on first day of the Great Fast, Monday, February 8, and on Good Friday, March 25.
 - C. All adult faithful – 18 year and older – are obligated to observe Strict Abstinence.
