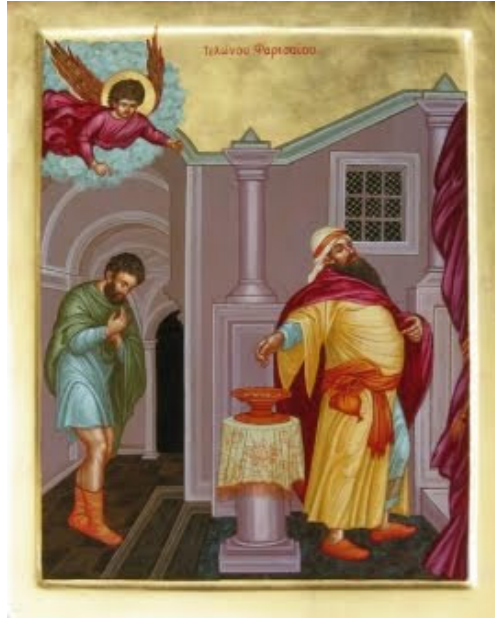

**Thinking ahead to the Great Fast:** Looking ahead, you will see we are about three weeks away from the beginning of the Great Fast. Now is a good time to start thinking about what to do for it.

**Sunday of the Publican and the Pharisee:** On this Sunday, we reflect on the importance of humility in our lives, no matter how far we might have progressed spiritually. The Pharisee had made good progress in his spiritual life and from what he said, we can assume he kept all the Commandments of the Torah perfectly. Yet he was filled with pride in telling God how impressed He who is God should be with one of His creatures, a Pharisee. Meanwhile, we can assume the Publican was not doing as well spiritually, yet he humbled himself before the Lord in prayer. It is the tradition (and part of our Particular Law *Sui Iuris*) in our Byzantine Catholic Church throughout the United States to be allowed to eat meat on the Friday following this particular Sunday in order to remind ourselves not to get too proud when we abstain from meat on Wednesdays and Fridays throughout the year.

**Year-end letters:** The year-end tax letters are now available for everyone who donated in 2018. If you have any questions about your letter and details, please contact Fr. Michael. Thank you very much for your generosity in 2018!

**New system for Liturgy stipends:** For those who request a Divine Liturgy for a personal intention, such as for living or deceased loved one, please pay attention. You should continue to make your request using our specially marked envelopes, *Liturgy Intentions*. However, the new system requires that checks be written to the parish, not the priest. As per the Eparchy's recent recommendation, St Anne's has opened a dedicated checking account for processing money given to the priest in the form of stipends for personal intentions for Divine Liturgies. As always, there is no charge for having a Divine Liturgy offered for a special intention, nor are you required to give any amount of money with the request. (We do not sell Holy Mysteries/Sacraments). However, it is customary to give a stipend to the priest who will offer a Liturgy for your personal intention. The suggested donation in our Pastoral Handbook is \$10. From a practical standpoint, there is not much different on your end. You can still give cash. However, if you are giving by check, please do not make it payable to the priest. Instead, make it payable to **St. Anne Stipends** and write "Liturgy Intention" in your memo line. The money will usually be deposited within about a week. It will be paid to the priest who offered the liturgy for your intention at some time after the Divine Liturgy has been celebrated. This new system enables better tracking of these requests, and allows the donation to be paid to whichever priest actually offers the liturgy, including a visiting priest.

**Submit All Soul's Saturday envelopes no later than February 17:** Our Byzantine tradition includes a beautiful series of five liturgies with panachidas offered for the souls of our loved ones. These liturgies occur before, during and after the Great Fast, and the 1st All Souls Saturday for 2019 will be on February 23. You are encouraged to fill out your All Soul's Saturday envelope and write on it the names of every deceased person you would like remembered - due by Sunday, February 17. The names are read out loud on each of the five All Soul's Saturdays. (Stipend checks for these envelopes should also be written out to **St. Anne Stipends** as in the announcement above.)
