## REGULATIONS FOR THE GREAT FAST

### 1. SIMPLE ABSTINENCE

A. This law forbids the use of meat and of meat by-products, such as beef broth), but permits the use of eggs and of dairy products.

B. Simple abstinence is to be observed on all Wednesdays and Fridays of the Great Fast.

C. All the faithful of the Eparchy who receive Holy Communion are obligated to abstain on these days.

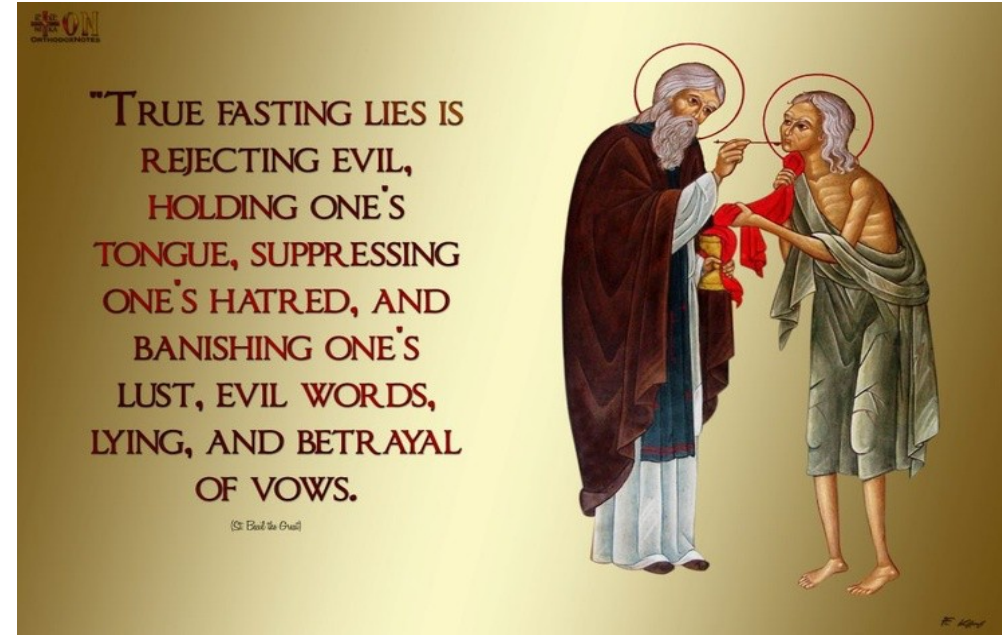
### 2. STRICT FAST

A. The law of Strict Fast or Abstinence forbids the use of meat, meat by-products, eggs and dairy products.

B. Strict Abstinence is to be observed on the First Day of the Great Fast, Monday February 27 and on Good Friday, April 14.

C. All adult faithful, eighteen years or older, are obligated to observe Strict Abstinence.
