St. Sabbas Gothinus, Martyr, a Christian soldier, confessed Christ, was tortured and cast into the river to drown A.D. 372, in the reign of Valentian and Valens, Emperors. SS. Basilissa and Anastasia, Martyrs, noble Roman ladies, among the first converts to Christianity, said to have given honorable burial to the bodies of SS. Peter and Paul, Apostles. For this they perished in the massacre of Christians incited and executed by Nero A.D. 68.

EASTERN CHRISTIAN FORMATION: contact Parish Office. See Bulletin.

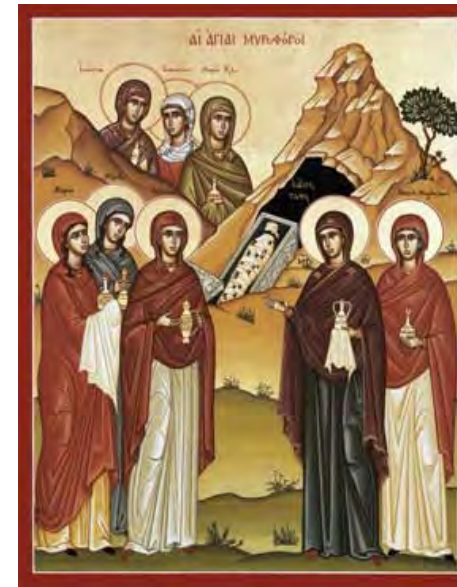
