According to the Typikon, there is to be strict abstinence (from meat, dairy, wine, and oil) on Mondays, Wednesdays, and Fridays, with a mitigated abstinence (wine and oil allowed) on Tuesday and Thursday. It is to help us prepare for the Great Feast of Sts. Peter and Paul on June 29, a Holy Day of Obligation.
