APOSTLES' FAST This period from May 28 (the day after the Sunday of All Saints) to June 28 is a penitential season in our Ruthenian Metropolia which means it is an optional fast. According to the Typikon, there is to be strict abstinence (from meat, dairy, wine, and oil) on Mondays, Wednesdays, and Fridays, with a mitigated abstinence (wine and oil allowed) on Tuesday and Thursday. It is to help us prepare for the Great Feast of Sts. Peter and Paul on June 29, a Holy Day of Obligation.

Reflection from St John Chrysostom: *Some argue that the centurion, by his description, implied the reason why he had not brought his servant to Jesus, saying, "Lord, my servant is lying paralyzed at home, in terrible distress," as though he was at his last gasp, or even, as Luke said, he was "at the point of death." In my opinion, however, the reason he had not brought him in was itself a sign of his great faith, even much greater than those who let the patient down through the roof.² Because the centurion knew for certain that even a mere command was enough for raising the servant up, he thought it unnecessary to bring him.*
