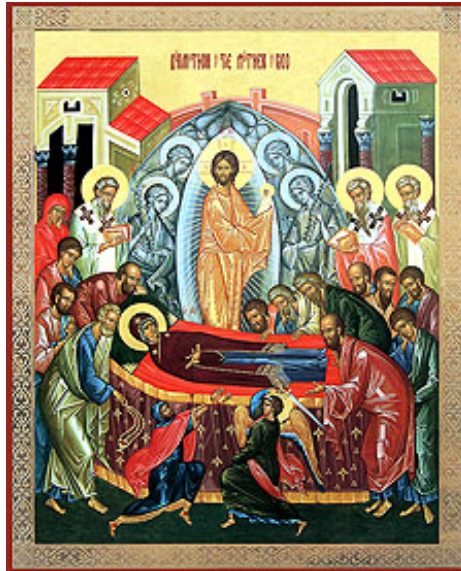

HOLY DAY OF OBLIGATION: Dormition of the Mother of God – August 15 is a Holy Day of Obligation of the Dormition of the Theotokos which corresponds to the Assumption of Mary in the Roman Catholic Church. Same feast, different emphasis in the East. Come to church on any of the three Divine Liturgies and bring flowers to be blessed. Any one Divine Liturgy fulfills your obligation. If this schedule doesn't work well for you, you need to find a Mass at a Roman Catholic Mass which does.

Prayer list resetting soon – The beginning of each liturgical new year begins September 1 for Byzantine Catholics and for Orthodox. At the recommendation of the Advisory Board, the prayer list will be "reset" and blank on the first weekend of September each year to make room for new intentions and new needs, thereby making sure that prayer intentions are current.
