It is considered to be our Lady's greatest Feast. The commemoration of her death and the Dormition (Assumption) of her body and soul into heaven was the occasion of special devotion in very early times. In Ephesus, it was observed even in the first century. In A.D. 1950, Pope Pius XII defined and promulgated the Dormition (Assumption) of the Theotokos to be a dogma of the Church.*
