URGENT SECURITY NOTICE

Church doors and windows are NOT being closed /locked on a regular basis leaving our beautiful church dangerously open for robbery and vandalism. Our priceless icons and sanctuary items are irreplaceable and our social hall would be wrecked.

Remember, all doors do not close and lock automatically without pushing the door physically to shut and lock; then check to be sure. Those few with keys are also obligated to lock and check the doors when leaving. Lights have been left on, sometimes all night and windows sometimes been left open and not locked after closing. Windows do not need to be opened. Please, it is mandatory that security be 100% as Fr. Milan cannot be available all the time to do a security check. Last person out must check all doors and windows both in the sanctuary and social hall locations. Your attention and cooperation is appreciated as we all use the church facilities.

ELEVATOR PROBLEM


Again, the elevator is malfunctioning due to improper use by many unnamed fingers pressing the elevator button multiple times. This is not a game. We now have to have an expensive repair done to the elevator[now out of order] before the annual elevator inspection required by the State of California. Please, your cooperation is necessary as the use of the elevator is for disabled or handicapped use only. To use, press the button once only and the button will become red, stand back and wait for the outer door to open and the inner folding door to open as well. Now enter elevator, press button 1 or 2 as needed, wait and inner door will close followed by outer door and elevator will move to your selected floor level. Finally, await for the outer door and inner door to open and then exit the elevator. Thank you for your cooperation and please educate all family members when to use and not use the elevator and the buttons to activate the elevator.

Environment for Children At the weather is warmer and children like to play outside the parish hall, it is important that parents supervise their own children as they outdoors, and also accompany them when they go to the restroom.
