EASTERN CHRISTIAN FORMATION: contact Parish Office. See Bulletin.

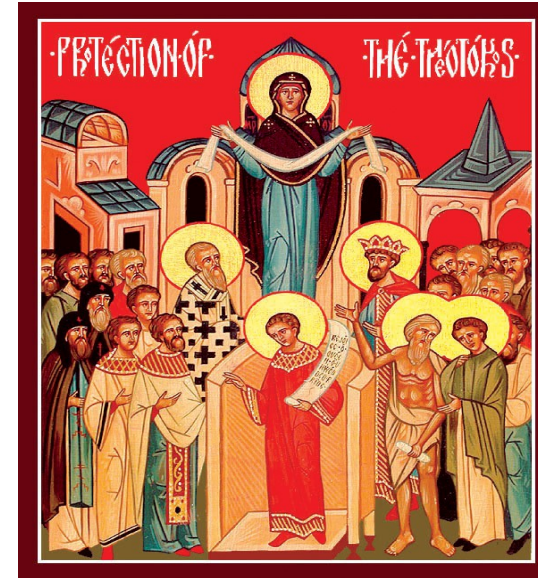
