**Opportunity! A free lecture series in Catholic Philosophy**– Dr. Thaddeus Kozinski has generously offered to teach an introduction to Catholic philosophy on Friday evenings after the 5:30pm Divine Liturgy, beginning on October 12 and continuing for several months. There will be a home-cooked dinner immediately following Divine Liturgy and before the class. The format will allow ample time for questions and discussion, followed by a Socratic conversation on a provocative philosophical question related to the lecture. This is a class for all backgrounds including older teenagers and adults of all ages where no outside reading or homework is required. Regular weekly attendance is encouraged, but not required. The entire class, including the lecture, questions, and Socratic seminar, will run approximately an hour and fifteen minutes.

Prior to his moving to San Luis Obispo with his family and joining St Anne's, Dr. Kozinski was Academic Dean and a professor of philosophy, theology, and humanities at Wyoming Catholic College. He is a regular contributor to The Imaginative Conservative online journal.
