Thank you! for the generous donations that many of you gave in the basket during the mirovanije blessing after liturgy last Sunday. These donations are personal gifts to the priest and do not go into the general church collection. The mirovanije blessing with oil traditionally takes place during the post-festive period of a feast day and also on the Sunday after a feast day. It will take place again next Sunday, November 25 because of the feast that took place on November 21. The bread is blessed bread (not Eucharist) and is available for anybody to eat.

We are in a fasting period: On Thursday, November 15, we began the Philip's Fast (aka Nativity Fast). During this time, we are preparing for the feast of Christmas. Are you doing anything differently? Have you added to the amount or quality of time you pray? Are you abstaining from certain foods to help you say no to sin and remind yourself of your hunger for God? Have you increased your generosity to the Church and to the poor during this season (Almsgiving)? This is food for thought.
