

The large "eternal" vigil oil lamps have a suggested offering of \$10.00 and will burn continuously from Sunday through Saturday. The other smaller oil lamps are each available for a suggested \$2.00 offering, which will burn for each Divine Liturgy for one week. The bulletin will remind your fellow parishioners of your special intention or loved one. See narthex envelopes.

**Feast of Our Lord's Baptism:** Roman Catholics celebrate the feast of the Wise Men (Magi) visiting the infant Jesus on January 6, while Byzantine Catholics and Orthodox celebrate the feast of Jesus' baptism by St. John the Baptist on that date. This feast is an important reminder of our baptism into the life of the Holy Trinity. It is such a great feast that our Byzantine Catholic Church has designated it as a Holy Day of Obligation. Although January 6 falls on a Sunday this year, I encourage you to attend the vigil on Saturday, January 5 if you are able. This glorious 3-hour service includes numerous Old Testament readings and the blessing of water.

MUCHAS GRACIAS!!! Look at the last page! We raised \$7,565 in our Christmas collection for the icons at St. Anne's!!! What a great achievement. All of this collection will be directed toward the icon fund. THANK YOU VERY MUCH FOR YOUR GENEROSITY. Dmitri Shkolnik, the iconographer, plans to arrive with his crew on March 18, and will work for two weeks to install the icons on the south and southeast walls and ceiling. He hopes to finish before Holy Week and Pascha (Easter). This phase will cost about \$48,000. Are you still considering giving to the icon fund to help pay for this endeavor? **Please turn in your parishioner registration sheet:** Several of you have given me your registration sheet. Thank you!! Your ministries sheets are a huge help to me and your updated contact information is very important too. If you are a parishioner and have not given me an updated form, please do so. Thank you.

**2019 Byzantine Wall Calendars and Parishioner envelopes are now available:** The boxes of envelopes for our parishioners arrived on Christmas Eve. This means we have them just in time before the New Year. These envelopes are for parishioners and the boxes are labeled for each household with a few exceptions. At this point, we are limiting wall calendars to one per registered family household who are getting a box of envelopes. Thank you.

**Bring your bottle to fill with Holy Water:** Every year, the great blessing of Holy Water takes place during the feast of Theophany during the vigil. Come bring empty bottles or jars to fill.

**PLAN AHEAD--make an appointment for your house blessing before January 15:** With the feast of the Holy Theophany (Baptism of Our Lord) on January 6 comes the season of annual house blessings. Now is the time to book your appointment with Fr. Michael. He is available at 5pm or 6pm most Sundays, Mondays, Tuesdays and Thursdays from January 8 - February 17.

When you request a house blessing, please give your preferred date with two alternative dates that could also work for you. Make your request by email or physical note. Thank you.
