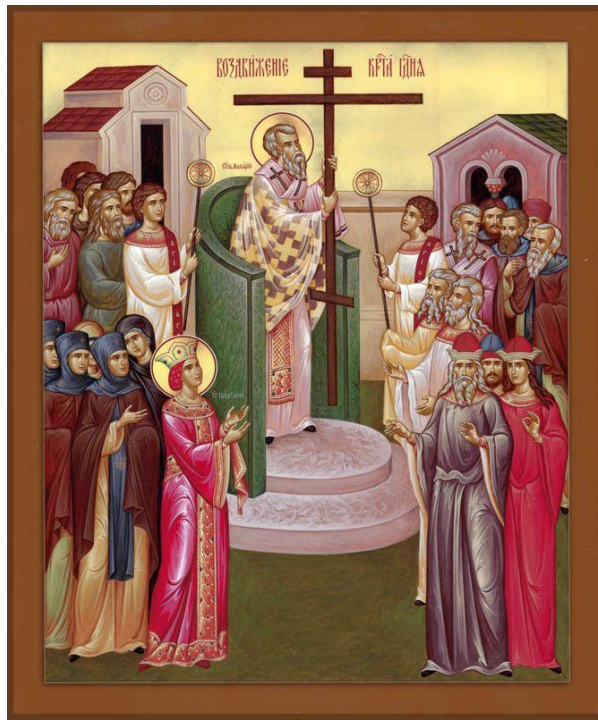

Make checks payable to **St. Anne Stipends** and write "Liturgy Stipend" in your memo line. Although donations are not required, the suggested stipend is \$10, which is later paid to the priest offering the Liturgy.

Two-part class series on the Divine Liturgy: During the Friday evening classes on March 29 and April 5, Fr. Michael will give an overview of the structure and theology of the Divine Liturgy. The classes will run from 7:30-9:00pm after the 5:30pm Presanctified Liturgy and free dinner at 7:00pm.

Eparchial Appeal update: As of March 20, St. Anne's has raised \$4,055 toward our \$7,425 goal from 14 of the 27 households. This means 51% of registered parishioners have participated. Thank you and bless you for your contributions! St Anne's is now at about 55% of the way toward fulfilling our monetary goal.
