Order forms for the various items are all due TODAY (April 7)! Please purchase some baked goods. They are traditional for Ruthenian (that's us) Easter baskets. Are you available to help tie branches for Palm Sunday? Are you available to help for about 30-60 minutes with tying up bundles of pussy-willows and olive branches with ribbons for Palm Sunday? It will take place after the 9am April 13 Liturgy.

Eparchial Appeal update: As of April 4, St. Anne's has raised \$5,085 toward our \$7,425 goal from 17 of the 27 households. This means 63% of registered parishioners have participated. Thank you and bless you for your contributions! St Anne's is now at about 68% of the way toward fulfilling our monetary goal.
