Eparchial Appeal update: As of April 10, St. Anne's has raised \$5,485 toward our \$7,425 goal from 18 of the 27 households. (If you sent a recent donation directly to the eparchy and credited St. Anne's, it is not included here as our latest update from the eparchy is from April 4) This means 66.7% of registered parishioners have participated. Thank you and may God bless you for your contributions! St Anne's is now at about 74% of the way toward fulfilling our monetary goal.
