“Sunday School” ECF registration due NEXT SUNDAY: It’s time to register your children for youth catechetical classes for the 2019-2020 school year. ECF stands for Eastern Christian Formation. Please register with our ECF Coordinator Ed Stewart by filling out the paperwork he has available so we know how many classes and teachers we need. It is very important that you meet the deadline of returning registration forms no later than next Sunday (Sept. 8) so we can plan ahead for the year in a timely manner.

Great Vespers: We do not have Great Vespers in our calendar very often so I encourage you to make the effort to come this Saturday, September 7 at 5pm for the feast of the Nativity of the Theotokos. At Vespers and Matins, we hear the theology of the feast in poetic prayer and it is a great way to start the beginning of any feast day. Come and see!
