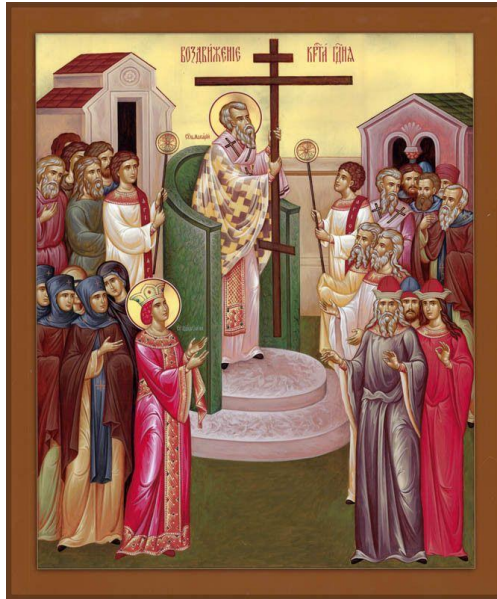

Byzantine Basics Classes start Tuesday, September 17: Would you like to better understand the nuances of the Byzantine Catholic Tradition? Do you want to deepen your knowledge of your Catholic faith? Then I encourage you to attend this series of classes - which are required for catechumens. We will use the three-volume series *Light for Life (Vol. 1: The Mystery Believed; Vol. 2: The Mystery Celebrated; Vol. 3: The Mystery Lived)* from *God with Us Publications*. Classes will begin at 7 PM on almost every other Tuesday. For the rest of 2019, classes will be on Sept. 17, Oct. 8, Oct. 29, Nov. 5, Nov. 19, Dec. 3, and Dec. 17.

Typicon order: These recipe books or how-to-manuals for how to celebrate the liturgical services of our Byzantine Ruthenian Catholic Church are called Typicons (also spelled Typikons). They are available by pre-ordering them from our Gift Shop. The common typicon needs to only be purchased once until a new edition comes out which is usually between 10 and 20 years. The annual typicon needs to be purchased every year to stay current. Most of this information is especially useful to cantors but is also useful to anyone wanting to understand how to pray Matins, Vespers, or the little hours. Order forms and payments are available in the Gift Shop and **due no later than next Sunday, Sept. 22.**

Jeff Baron focusing on his family: Last Sunday, Jeff Baron informed me that he has decided to withdraw from the rigors and intensity of the diaconate formation program in order to better take care of his family. We commend Jeff on this discernment and ask that God bless him in every way.

40 Days for Life: Sept. 29 to Nov. 3: Our parish will be involved like before with two groups of people. One group will meet in front of the abortion clinic at 743 Pismo Street in San Luis Obispo while the other group will be meeting at St. Anne's praying silently. This will be from 1-3pm on Sundays.

DONATION FOR \$48,252.00! St Anne's has been the recipient of wonderful generosity. On July 3, I presented a letter to the local San Luis Obispo Knights of Columbus council 1271 requesting their financial assistance with essential, expensive repairs to our church structure. This letter contained explanations of the causes and extent of the structural damage, plus contractor estimates and drawings for the following: (1) Replace our rotting wooden retaining wall on the east side of the church with a concrete retaining wall set further into the hillside; (2) Excavate and seal the foundation of the church on the north side with a waterproof membrane and improved drainage; (3) Paint the whole exterior of the church which has cracked stucco. The Council agreed to give us our entire request of \$48,252, and we received the check from them on Sept. 4. We hope to begin repairs soon.
