St Anne's needs more ushers: Our parish is seeking two or three dedicated men to become new ushers - because some people have retired from this task due to health problems. We thank them for their faithful service. This vital work includes welcoming and assisting parishioners and visitors, guiding people to Communion, collecting money in the baskets, implementing safety protocols if needed, and handing out bulletins at the end of Divine Liturgy. Our ushers represent the face of the Catholic Church and St Anne's to parishioners and visitors. They should be available to greet people at the door no later than 9:45 AM on Sundays, and must wear a collared shirt that is tucked in (a necktie and suit jacket is an appreciated bonus) with slacks (no jeans) and a belt. 40 Days for Life: Sept. 29 to Nov. 3: Our parish will be involved with 40 Days for Life in two separate groups. One group will meet in front of the abortion clinic at 743 Pismo Street in San Luis Obispo, while the other group will meet at St. Anne's to pray silently. This will be from 1-3 PM on Sundays beginning next Sunday.

Rosary Coast to Coast—St. Anne's participation: The annual Rosary prayed on beaches for the healing of the Church and America will take place on Sunday, October 13. Our parish participants will meet at Avila Beach—Port San Luis Strand at 1 PM. Please pick up a flyer for more information.

Byzantine Basics Classes began last Tuesday: Would you like to better understand the nuances of the Byzantine Catholic Tradition? Do you want to deepen your knowledge of your Catholic faith? Then I encourage you to attend this series of classes - which are required for catechumens. We will use the three-volume series *Light for Life* (Vol. 1: *The Mystery Believed*; Vol. 2: *The Mystery Celebrated*; Vol. 3: *The Mystery Lived*) from *God with Us* Publications. Classes will begin at 7 PM on almost every other Tuesday. Our remaining classes for 2019 will be Oct. 8, Oct. 29, Nov. 5, Nov. 19, Dec. 3, and Dec. 17.

Byzantine Tidbit – The 7th Ecumenical Council: This important Ecumenical Council concerns the veneration of icons and is celebrated in our Byzantine Catholic Church on the Sunday that falls between October 11-17. The name of that Sunday is called the "Sunday of the Fathers at the 7th Ecumenical Council." The Council took place in 787 AD and decreed that veneration of an icon is not idolatry, but rather a veneration of the person(s) depicted in it.
