40 Days for Life: Sept. 29 to Nov. 3: Our parish will be involved with 40 Days for Life in two separate groups. One group will meet in front of the abortion clinic at 743 Pismo Street in San Luis Obispo, while the other group will meet at St. Anne's to pray silently. This will be from 1-3 PM on Sundays beginning today (Sept. 29).
