**Rosary Coast to Coast—St. Anne’s participation:** The annual Rosary prayed on beaches for the healing of the Church and America will take place today, October 13. Our parish participants will join others who meet at Avila Beach—Port San Luis Strand at 1 PM. Please pick up a flyer for more information.

**Special Collection for Eparchial Clergy Health Insurance:** Today, October 13, St Anne’s will have a special collection to help pay health insurance premiums for clergy and their families. Although each parish pays \$1,100 per month to the eparchy for these health insurance premiums, this does not cover the full cost of the premiums. Here is a quote from the eparchy’s financial update that helps explain the need for this special collection to cover the shortage: *With regard to actual costs, for the first 9 months of this year (Jan – Sep) our health care costs totaled \$278,186.73, or approximately \$30,910.00 per month. Our monthly billing to parishes for this expense, for that same period, was \$203,525.00, or approximately \$22,614.00 per month, leaving a gap between income and expense in this area of about \$8,296.00 per month. For 12 months, the gap will total about \$99,552.00. Last year, in 2018, our special collection for this purpose raised \$25,159.15, which, as you can see from the numbers, was very helpful.* Thank you in advance for your generosity for this year’s collection. If you forgot or were unable to bring your special envelope today, don’t worry. You have until November 3 to donate. If you write a check, please write it to the parish with “Priests Medical Collection” in the memo line. May God bless you for your support and generosity!

**In-House Training for Safe Environment cancelled:** The in-house training for Safe Environment that was scheduled for Sunday, October 20 has been cancelled. Since the training is available online through Virtus, Ed Stewart is learning how to direct our adults to take this training online.
