Next Special Collection for Retired Religious: In a few weeks, we will be taking of the Retirement Fund for Religious (RFR) on December 13. The RFR began in 1988 and provides funding to any U.S. Catholic religious institute listed in the Official Catholic Directory (OCD) with an identifying OCD number, and that has an unfunded past service liability. It distributes direct care, planning and implementation assistance from the fund to religious institutes based on criteria approved by the conferences of major superiors and bishops. All of the proceeds of this special collection go to the National Religious Retirement Office.
