New Alarm System and Keys: To enhance security at St Anne's, we have installed a new alarm system and are changing church keys. If you have an old key and have not spoken to Fr. Michael recently about getting a new one, as well as the new alarm code, please see him soon.

Friday evening classes: Beginning November 15, we will be having classes on the third Friday of almost every month after the 5:30pm Divine Liturgy that is normally scheduled on Friday evenings. THE WOMAN REMAINS HIDDEN. St. Cyril of Alexandria says regarding today's Gospel: "What made that sick woman wish to remain hidden? The law of wise Moses imputed impurity to any woman who was suffering from a flow of blood and everywhere called her unclean. Whoever was unclean could not touch anything that was holy or approach a holy man. For this reason, the woman was careful to remain concealed, for fear that having transgressed the law she should have to bear the punishment which it imposed. When she touched, she was healed immediately and without delay."
