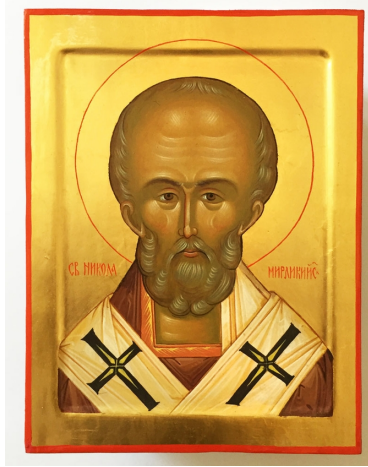

Next Special Collection for Retired Religious: On December 13, we will have a special collection the Retirement Fund for Religious (RFR). The RFR began in 1988 and provides funding to any U.S. Catholic religious institute listed in the Official Catholic Directory (OCD) and that has an unfunded past service liability. It distributes direct care, planning and implementation assistance from the fund to religious institutes based on criteria approved by the conferences of major superiors and bishops. All of the proceeds of this special collection go to the National Religious Retirement Office.

Byzantine Basics discontinued until January: The Tuesday night classes are being cancelled for the rest of December and hopefully will start up again in January.

Asking for feedback on Christmas Eve: I (Fr. Michael) am planning ahead for the Christmas services. Last year, we had Vigil Vespers Divine Liturgy at 4:30pm followed by a Holy Supper at approximately 6:45pm. Traditionally, Holy Supper is a meal eaten at home with no meat (or dairy) and with dishes that are traditional to the Slavic regions from which our Ruthenian Byzantine Catholic Church gets its heritage. The meal is normally eaten before the vigil service. We had a potluck Holy Supper last year and will do so again this year, allowing dairy but no meat. We could have the parish Holy Supper at 5pm and start Liturgy at 7pm or have the Liturgy at 5pm and eat at approximately 7:15pm. Please let me know your preference this week so I can determine what works best for most people and put that into the bulletin schedule.
