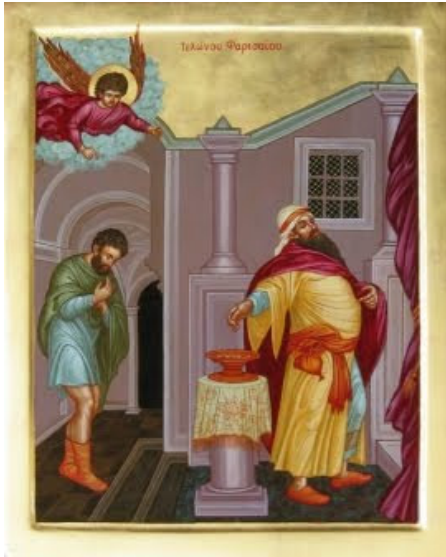

This is the day in which the Byzantine Church exhorts us to give and receive forgiveness to other people.

According to the Traditional Fast, this is also the last day to eat up cheese and dairy products at home.

February 24: First Day of the Great Fast (Lent)

*This begins two days earlier for Byzantines than Romans. On this day, we are REQUIRED by the Church to abstain from BOTH **meat AND dairy products** including eggs.*

LITURGY INTENTIONS Please fill out one of the Liturgy Intention envelopes on the greeting table in the narthex with the name of your living or deceased person. Make checks payable to **St. Anne Stipends** and write "Liturgy Stipend" in your memo line. Although donations are not required, the suggested stipend is \$10, which is later paid to the priest offering the Liturgy.

You should have your year-end tax letters by now: Last Sunday, your 2019 year-end donation letters were made available in the narthex. Anything not picked up was mailed on Monday, January 27. Therefore, everyone who donated to St. Anne's in 2019 in specifically marked envelopes should have received their letter. If it got lost in the mail and you did not receive it, be sure to let Fr. Michael know as he has a scan of all those letters and can get you a copy. If we made an error on anything, please bring any supporting documentation such as check scans and bank statements to Fr. Michael no later than one month before any tax filing deadline so the problem can be rectified in time.

2020 boxes of envelopes coming soon: An email conversation with the envelope company we use revealed they mailed our 2020 boxes of envelopes last week and should arrive next week. Therefore, all boxes of envelopes should be available in the narthex next Sunday, February 9.

Submit All Soul's Saturday envelopes no later than next Sunday, February 9: Our Byzantine tradition includes a beautiful series of five Divine Liturgies with Panachidas offered for the souls of our loved ones. These liturgies occur before, during, and after the Great Fast, and the 1st All Souls Saturday for 2020 will be on February 15. You are encouraged to fill out your All Soul's Saturday envelope and write the names of every deceased person you would like remembered (attach an additional sheet if you need more room); due no later than next Sunday. The names are read out loud on each of the five All Soul's Saturdays. (Stipend checks for these envelopes should also be written out to "St. Anne Stipends" with "All Souls" in the memo. These offerings are not tax-deductible and are a stipend to the priest.) Our envelope company sent us All Souls envelopes separately from the boxes of envelopes so we could have them by today in time before next Sunday's deadline to submit names.
