Eparchial Appeal Update: As of July 10, the Eparchy reported that **20 households from St. Anne's have contributed \$7,380.75** (and pledged \$7,580.75) toward **our parish goal in 2020 of \$9,961.09**. We are 74% toward reaching our goal. The Eparchy assessed our parish about \$356 per family/household this year. Thank you very much to those who have donated. May God bless you!

Bulletin error: Nobody took up Fr. Michael on the challenge to find at least one bulletin error in the June 21 bulletin. The most obvious error was that it said the "Fourth Sunday after Pentecost" instead of the third. This error is easily found by consulting your wall calendar which indicates the tone of the week which begins on Sunday and what type of Sunday it is. From Pentecost until the beginning of the Great Fast (Lent), most Sundays are in reference to its distance from Pentecost Sunday since it is at that point that the Church has its birthday and Jesus' mandate in Matthew 28 is begun.

All-Night Prayer Vigil at St Anne's on August 14-15: Our country, the world and the Catholic Church greatly need the regular fervent prayers of each one of us. St Anne's will hold an All-Night Vigil of intense prayer on the night of August 14-15 which is the Feast of the Dormition of the Theotokos. Please let Fr.
