All-Night Prayer Vigil at St Anne's on August 14-15: Our country, the world and the Catholic Church greatly need the regular fervent prayers of each one of us. St Anne's will hold an All-Night Vigil of intense prayer on the night of August 14-15 which is the Feast of the Dormition of the Theotokos. Please let Fr. Michael know if you can attend for an hour or more. Also, please let him know if you can help with planning.

Outdoor Divine Liturgies: We are having our two Sunday Divine Liturgies outdoors due to the latest California COVID safety guidelines. For increased precaution, our bishop wants us to wear face masks during the liturgical services outdoors. We will also be singing! Talk to Fr. Michael or email him if you have questions.

Coffee Socials starting up again: We are pleased to begin the coffee socials for the first time since March! It will not be self-service, but the coffee will be served to you. Packages of food and water are also available. Please wait for a server wearing gloves and a mask to give you what you are looking for.

Bring your cars tomorrow (Monday): On the feast of St. Elias, it is our Byzantine tradition to bless cars. Because St. Elias (Elijah) was taken up on a fiery chariot into heaven, it is a good time for us to bless chariots whether those drawn by horses (very rare these days) or those which are horseless. If you have more than one car, you might each family member to drive separately that day. Cars and trucks will be blessed at the end of each Divine Liturgy.

Patronal feast on Saturday: This Saturday is our patronal feast day of St. Anne! Let's come to church and honor her and ask for her continued prayers.
