Processions for Conversion to Christ: Please join fellow parishioners and friends of St Anne's in marches (religious processions) to publicly proclaim our Lord and Savior, Jesus Christ. We will carry holy icons and written signs that invite others to participate in our life-giving and salvific faith in Him.

Two peaceful, prayerful marches are currently planned, on Sunday afternoons, August 2 and 9, from 12:30 to 1:30pm. In these days of often violent protests, our people will be praying, not shouting, and joyfully witnessing to our Catholic faith. We will process from the church along Foothill Boulevard and turn around at Santa Rosa Street back to St. Anne's. I strongly encourage you to participate. Bring your families. Since we are outdoors, you do not have to wear a mask from the virus, but please make sure to maintain physical distancing between you and other households/carloads. Walk as much or as little as you're able. Let us be brave and bold in the Name of Our Lord Jesus Christ!

Dormition Fast, August 1 - 14: The Ruthenian Metropolia has identified this period as a penitential season (Canon 880-2). Although the observance of this fast is voluntary, the traditional rule for the Dormition Fast is strict abstinence (no meat, eggs, dairy products) from August 1 to 14, except for days of mitigation, which are Saturdays, Sundays, and the Feast of the Transfiguration on August 6.

Even if you modify the traditional, strict fast, I strongly encourage you to observe some rule of fasting and abstinence in preparation for the glorious Feast of Dormition on August 15. By adopting a rule of fasting that restrains your physical appetites, you also develop a spiritual discipline and strength that helps you reject sin. Fasting should remind us of our hunger for God and always be accompanied by increased prayer.

All-Night Prayer Vigil at St Anne's on August 14-15: Our country, the world and the Catholic Church greatly need the regular fervent prayers of each one of us. St Anne's will hold an All-Night Vigil of intense prayer on the night of August 14-15 which is the Feast of the Dormition of the Theotokos. Please let Fr. Michael know if you can attend for an hour or more. Also, please let him know if you can help with planning.
