**REGARDING THE SPIRITUAL VEIL THAT COVERS THE MIND AND HEART IN 1 CORINTHIANS 3: 12-18.** ST. JOHN CHRYSOSTOM: "The veil is not there because of Moses but because of their gross and carnal minds.....The purpose of the veil was not to hide Moses but to prevent the Jews from seeing him, for they were unable to do so. But when we turn to the Lord, the veil is naturally taken away. When Moses talked with the Jews, he had his face covered, but when he talked with God, the veil was removed. Likewise when we turn to the Lord, we shall see the glory of the law and the face of the Lawgiver uncovered. And not only this, we shall then be in the same frame of reference as Moses."
