Entrance to St. Anne's from back end most days: We have had lots of traffic going through our parking lot via wheels and foot. In an effort to curb that back, we have put up a ribbon barrier with cones at either end. Therefore, the Foothill Blvd. entrance is closed except on Sunday mornings from about 9am to 10am and perhaps right before Divine Liturgy (until the beginning of Liturgy) on major feast days.
