Eparchial Appeal update: As of September 3, a total of 20 families from St. Anne's have contributed \$8,225.75 toward our \$9,961.09 goal in 2020 for our parish. September 13: March for Conversion: We are continuing our Marches for Conversion on the second Sunday of each month for six more months going through February. Our next March is September 13 from 12:30 to 1:30pm. In these days of often violent protests, our people will be praying, not shouting, and joyfully witnessing to our Catholic faith. We will process from the church along Foothill Boulevard and turn around at Santa Rosa Street back to St. Anne's. You are advised to maintain physical distance between you and other households and wear a face mask or face shield to help prevent spread of the virus. I strongly encourage you to participate! Bring your families. Let us be brave and bold in the Name of Our Lord Jesus Christ!

Chrismation on Sunday, September 13: Next Sunday, Rebecca Prewett will make a Profession of Faith, receive the Holy Mystery of Chrismation and receive Jesus' body and blood! She comes from the Anglican Church and was baptized many decades ago. St Anne's is blessed to have her become Catholic and part of our parish family. Rebecca has been taking classes with Fr. Michael since March in preparation for this. What a great and marvelous day for her! Please keep her in your prayers.

Typicons must be ordered by NEXT SUNDAY: The Typicon (also spelled Typikon) is a "how-to manual" for celebrating the liturgical services of our Byzantine Ruthenian Catholic Church. The common typicon needs to be purchased only once until a new edition comes out, every 10 - 20 years. However, the annual typicon needs to be purchased every year to stay current. These materials are especially useful to cantors, but can be helpful to anyone wanting to understand how to pray Matins, Vespers, and the little hours. Typicons are available by Pre-Order from our Gift Shop. Order forms and payments are **due no later than next Sunday, September 13.**
