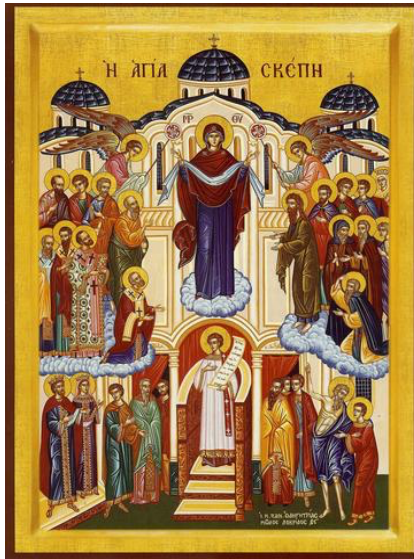

Eparchial Appeal update: As of September 18, a total of 20 families from St. Anne's have **contributed \$8,325.75 toward our \$9,961.09 goal in 2020 for our parish.** We are **83.6%** toward reaching our goal. ECF year begins officially on October 4: This year, Christina Aguirre will be teaching younger children and early teens while Sean Baird will continue to teach older teens and young adults on Sundays from about 11:45am to 12:30pm. Both Christina and Sean will receive a special catechist blessing and the children will receive a special blessing at the end of this Sunday Divine Liturgy. Haven't enrolled your child yet? Talk to Fr. Michael, Christina, or Sean to get setup.

Resources for Learning and Teaching the Catholic Faith: This year many catechetical resources are available to parents and other adults who want to continue to learn and teach the Faith at <https://godwithusonline.org>. The next major class takes place on Wednesday evenings from October 7-28 from 5-6pm Pacific time on the topic of the Art of Catechesis in our Tradition with emphasis on the Divine Liturgy.

Group training for volunteers to take place on Sunday, October 25: Last year, we began a new system for our volunteers who have contact with minors or are in a position of authority and trust which involved completing Virtus training online every year and completing a background check every five years. Due to the complication many of us had with completing the online training, we will do a group, in-person session on Sunday, October 25 from noon until about 1:15pm. The online option will still be available to those who cannot make this session, but we wanted to have something that all volunteers, whether computer savvy or not could complete.

Adult classes to begin in October: Fr. Michael will begin a catechetical series for adults next month. It will either be Tuesday or Friday evenings. If you have a preference, let him know soon. The date to begin is unknown due to Fr. Michael's jury duty on October 13.

October 18: March for Conversion: Our next March is October 18 from 12:30 to 1:30pm. Please mark your calendars.

Coast-to-Coast Rosary on Sunday, October 11: You can participate in this important prayer event at 1 PM at St Anne's and a few other Catholic Churches in the area. In addition, a group will pray at the courthouse on the Monterey Street side in downtown San Luis Obispo. We begin gathering at 12:30pm. I encourage you to come and pray with us.

Evening liturgy on October 1 starts at 5:30pm OR 6:30pm: The start time is tentative for evening liturgy on the great feast of the Protection of the Theotokos on October 1. If you have not received an email with the final time by September 30, please call or email before driving to the church.
