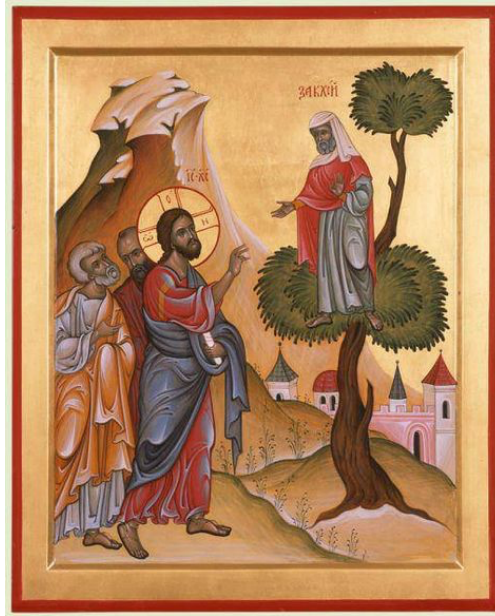

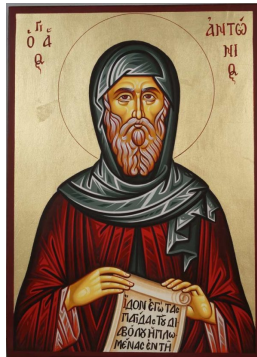
Make an appointment for your house blessing by January 19: House blessing season runs from Theophany (Jan. 6) until the day before the Great Fast (Feb. 14, 2021). Now is the time to book an appointment to have your house blessed. Fr. Michael is available at 5pm or 6pm most Sundays, Tuesdays, and Thursdays from January 17 - February 14. If providing dinner afterward, please NO mushrooms (cooked or uncooked) or raw tomatoes (cooked tomatoes are fine).

Last March for Conversion on January 24: Our final March for Conversion will be on Sunday, January 24 from 12:30-1:30pm. Although we may have an occasional march in the future, this will be the last of a seven-march series begun in August of last year.

Catechesis for adults to begin on February 25 at St Anne's: Our Thursday evening adult classes will be at 7:00 -8:15 PM starting on February 25, during the second week of the Great Fast. We will study basics of the Byzantine approach (Byzantine Basics), the Divine Liturgy as a mystical experience of God, as well as the Gospel of John, the most mystical of the Gospels in pointing to Christ's divinity. Besides a Bible, we will use the *Light for Life* three-volume series, which is available for purchase in our gift shop or online. You will be able to participate in person or online through the Zoom platform.
