Eparchial Appeal 2021

St Anne's registered parishioners have received a mailing from the Eparchy of Phoenix asking you to participate in the 2021 Eparchial Appeal. The current goal for the entire Eparchy is \$300,000, of which St Anne's parish was assigned a goal of \$12,355.21. If each household donates an average of \$375, we will reach our goal. Some can give more and others less, but we can all participate. If donating through the parish, please make checks payable to St. Anne Church and write "Eparchial Appeal" in the memo line. As of June 23, St Anne's has received \$9,485 for the Eparchial Appeal, which brings us to almost 77% of our goal. We're over ¾ of the way! This is the most important special collection of the year for us. Thank you for donating.

Preparing to install a fence and gate

We are preparing to install a fence and gate on the south side of our property at Foothill Boulevard. This is to help protect our very young children after Divine Liturgy on Sundays from running into that busy street. It will also stop people (mainly students and other people) from walking or driving through our parking lot to avoid going a ½ block further to Patricia Drive to connect with Foothill Boulevard. This helps create an area that is safe with an enclosure that we can better enjoy as a parish. Signage will be installed on the gate letting people know how to access the church on weekdays from the back entrance. As an extra bonus, we have secured a donation from a parishioner to pay for the contractor to do the work! Yay!
