On October 31, 2021, Dr. Bill Carnazzo was blessed to have his wife, two priest sons Fr. Sebastian and Fr. Hezekias, their wives, and another one of his daughters and granddaughters along with me (Fr. Michael) at his side until his last breath at 7:35pm. The three of us priests prayed the prayers for the dying, anointed him, and he received the Eucharist before he left this life. It was a blessed time.

- **Wednesday, November 10 at 6:30pm**—Funeral Parastas (Ruthenian Byzantine recension)
- **Thursday, November 11 at 11:00am**—**FUNERAL SERVICE** (Melkite Byzantine recension)
- **Thursday, November 11**—**Mercy meal luncheon** after the funeral service at our downstairs St. Anne's social hall. (to be prepared by the St. George Melkite Church parishioners).
- **Friday, November 12 at 1:00pm**—Burial service at San Carlos Cemetery (792 Fremont St, Monterey, CA 93940)
- **Friday, November 12**—**Reception** hosted at Fr. Sebastian's home in Prunedale, CA after the burial service. More info available from Fr. Sebastian.

**The (two) main funeral services designed for everyone are the Wednesday evening Ruthenian Byzantine Parastas and Thursday morning Melkite Byzantine Funeral service. The Thursday morning liturgical service is the main funeral service (if you can only attend one).**

**After the Thursday morning** funeral service, all the participants are welcome to attend the luncheon mercy meal afterwards at St. Anne's.

**Live-streaming:** The liturgical services are available for live-streaming in the *parking lot* in case there is overflow or a desire to physically distance from large crowds during covid times. We anticipate a HUGE crowd for the *Thursday morning service* and to a lesser extent the other two services on Wednesday. The **live-streaming links** are *available from me (Fr. Michael)* upon request, so just let me know if you'd like that. We will also have the TV screen available for overflow in the downstairs social hall.

**Attire:** The family asked me to remind everyone to wear appropriate, modest dress clothing suitable for honoring God in church. Your attention to that matter is appreciated.
