Thank you for responding to my call to participate in the Eparchial Appeal: Great news! Over the past few weeks, several of you donated through our parish or to the Eparchy directly. As of July 20, the Eparchy reported to us a total of \$13,280. We sent a \$400 parish check in the mail to the Eparchy for July 17, which brought us to \$13,680, and about 89% of our parish goal. St Anne's just received another check which will be deposited with the July 24 collection. Thank you for responding to my call to get us to the finish line.

Typicon 2023 order

The Typicon (also spelled Typikon) is a "how-to manual" for celebrating the liturgical services of our Byzantine Ruthenian Catholic Church. The common typicon needs to be purchased only once until a new edition comes out (usually every 10 - 20 years). However, the annual typicon needs to be purchased every year to stay current. These materials are especially useful to cantors, but can be helpful to anyone wanting to understand how to pray Matins, Vespers, the little hours, and Divine Liturgy. Typicons are available for \$20 each by Pre-Order from our Gift Shop. Order forms (available in the gift shop) and payments are **due no later than Sunday, August 21, 2022.**

SURVEY REQUEST: At the clergy conference in June, efforts were begun to help our eparchy send in information for the upcoming **Synod on Synodality** initiated by Pope Francis and the Synod of Bishops. It was decided to initiate a confidential survey of all of our parishes related to the dimensions of Communion, Participation, and Mission in order to get this going.
