

All Souls Saturdays—DUE SUNDAY, FEBRUARY 5: In the Byzantine Tradition, we pray Memorial Divine Liturgies five times a year for the souls of our Faithful Departed. These All Souls Saturdays occur on the Saturday before Meatfare Sunday (this year Feb. 11), three Saturdays during the Great Fast (Lent), and the Saturday before Pentecost Sunday.

During the All Souls Saturdays services, the priest prays for your deceased loved ones by name. To enable him to include the names of your own departed faithful, please turn in your envelope. If you did not receive a packet of envelopes you may email your list of names to Fr. Michael or give him a printed list. Fill out the envelope with the names of your deceased loved ones; write first names only please. If you wish to include whole deceased family lines, you may commemorate them by writing "Smith Family" etc. You may also write additional names on the back of the envelope.

If you wish to give a stipend to the priest, you may do so, but this is not required. If you write a check for the stipend, please make it out to St. Anne Stipends and write "All Souls" in the memo line. **DUE DATE:** 2/5/2023
